Major Retailers Want to Give Our Band Program Money!

We're pleased to share some exciting news about a new fundraising program for our organization. It's called "**Scrip**", and it's the fundraising program that works while you shop.

Scrip is simply a word that means, "Substitute money" – in other words, scrip is gift certificates/cards from national and local retailers. They're the same gift certificates that you buy at the store. Many popular retailers participate in our scrip program including JC Penney, Macy's, The Gap, Shell, American Eagle Outfitters, Old Navy, Pizza Hut, Starbucks, and many, many others. We also have Kroger participating.

You're probably asking yourself how these stores help us raise money. It's simple – scrip participating retailers agree to sell gift certificates to our organization at a discount. Member families like yours buy the certificate for full face value, they redeem them for full face value, and our organization keeps the difference as revenue. Each family's percent of revenue is credited to their child's fundraising account (50% of proceeds -- June & July **ONLY**).

The beauty of scrip is that you put your regular household shopping dollars to work. You earn money for your fundraising account without spending a single additional penny. Just spend your regular shopping dollars with scrip at the stores that participate in the scrip program! Scrip can be used for just about any household purchase including food, clothing, entertainment, gas, and even dining out.
