General Membership Meeting
July 23, 2006

The General Membership Meeting of the Peachtree Band Boosters Association was held on July 23, 2006. Angelia Morgan called the meeting to order. The minutes from the May meeting were approved. The treasurer's report showed a net income of \$179,575.30. Sue Elliott reported on current income and expenses.

Angelia Morgan reported that the Visitor stands in the football stadium are completed and the band will operate the concession stand. Tara Gillespie will be overseeing the concession stand and is currently seeking volunteers to work during home football games.

Donna Pate presented information about Rock-A-Thon which will take place on September 9, 2006. She stressed that 100% participation is needed to meet the fundraising goal of \$27,500.00.

Jan Madert reported on how the Scrip fundraising program will work for the remainder of the school year. She indicated that this has been a successful fundraiser this summer and encouraged families to participate.

Jan Madert introduced Cindy Sandage who is in charge of spiritwear. Orders are currently being taken on-line via the PRBBA website.

Angelia Morgan discussed the importance of parent involvement which is essential for the success of the program. Chaperone trainings will take place on July 27th and August 15th. Other opportunities to get involved include volunteering with Pit Crew, Hospitality and the Concession Stand.

Angelia Morgan reported that picture day for the Fall Sports Program will be on August 12th. Ads for the Fall Sports Program are currently being accepted.

Jeff Cegalis presented an update of plans for the Hawaii Trip in November.
